



2026-2027 American Chuck Wagon Association's \$1000 Scholarship Application

It is not only the mission of the American Chuck Wagon Association Scholarship Fund to provide financial assistance to those continuing their education in a collegiate or trade program, but to also seek out those students showing interest and promise (past, present and future) as strong advocates for the ACWA. ACWA scholarships are awarded on an annual basis. Half the awarded amount of scholarship will be applied to the first semester and the other half the second contingent upon satisfactory progress. Funds are sent directly to the educational institution for each semester or quarter. **Application period is January 1st till February 28th.**

This application and support documents must be submitted by February 28th. Note: If sending your application and documents through USPS, the envelope must be postmarked before or on February 28th.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

In order to receive this Scholarship you must:

- Be enrolling as a first-time college student or returning undergraduate student.
- Be pursuing an approved degree at an accredited college, university or trade school.
- Be a full-time student (12 semester hours or the equivalent) in the educational program.
- Maintain a minimum GPA of 2.50 each semester. Transcripts of grades must be provided to ACWA to maintain the scholarship.
- This scholarship is open to anyone with preference to a member of ACWA or the relative of an ACWA member.
- Must have a high school diploma, a GED or be a high school senior accepted in an educational institution.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

This application must be accompanied by:

- A high school transcript OR, if enrolled at an institute other than high school, a current copy of your transcript.
- Three letters of recommendation. Suggested references might be from a teacher, principal, counselor, 4-H leader, employer, or such that reveal attitude, ethics, and social standing among peers and/or elders.

RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarship may be renewed on an academic year basis, contingent upon satisfactory academic progress and availability of funds. Students must submit proof of GPA of 2.50 or better for the previous year along with a brief essay describing how the scholarship benefited you and why it should be renewed by the deadline for the next academic year.

REVOCAION OF AID

The ACWA scholarship committee reserves the right to revoke any scholarship or aid awarded at any time if the applicant fails to meet the standards of academic progress, any other scholarship requirement or falsifies information reported.
